COURSE OBJECTIVES: Insolvency is a financial malaise that afflicts the economy and society. Law has to effectively deal with this malaise. Indian Parliament has repealed the laws dealing with insolvency and bankruptcy and passed the Insolvency and Bankruptcy

Code, 2016(IBC) to consolidate the laws relating to insolvency and bankruptcy of corporate persons, individuals and corporate firms and to expedite resolutions with maximization of the value of assets. The objective of this course is to teach and learn IBC in depth. This course will include the study of the historical background of IBC, aims and objectives of IBC, the role, powers and functions of Insolvency Bankruptcy Board of India, provisions of IBC as to corporate persons, Limited Liability Partnership firms, individuals and partnership firms.

COURSE OUTCOMES:

- 1. Understand laws applicable to creditors' rights and bankruptcy in general.
- 2. Apply basic business concepts in accounting, finance, and economics specifically relevant and related to the understanding of bankruptcy
- Analyse issues related to advising the debtor or creditors arising under federal bankruptcy law, including issues related to bankruptcy claims, making claims under bankruptcy and avoidance.

- Create and appreciate the relationship between the government and IBBI to understand Board's Fund, Insolvency and Bankruptcy Fund, relevant regulations

framed by IBBI and rules framed by the government.
