COURSE OBJECTIVES:

This course is designed to teach new norm of relationship between the state and its citizenship, also outline the knowledge about civil service and administrative agencies, standard of administrative behaviour supported by constitutional values. The lawyers practicing at High Courts and the Supreme Court must have the detailed knowledge of administrative law. Day in and day out large number of cases are filed before the court against Government and Administration and to equip lawyers to deal with them effectively this course is prescribed at post graduate level. An attempt is made to avoid those aspects of administrative law that are covered at undergraduate level. It enables the students to acquire knowledge about the body of law that governs the administration and regulation of

government authorities. Students acquire knowledge on the administrative functions and the manner in which it is implemented by the administrators for an able government.
