COURSE OBJECTIVES:

In order to acquaint students with the development of the field of international relations as well as the contemporary Nation-State system, this course on international relations is presented in the fourth semester. The goal of the course is to deepen students' understanding and investigation of the interactions between the major players in international relations—the sovereign state and non-sovereign entities—as well as their power dynamics in the modern world. Students will comprehend the several types of dispute resolution mechanisms outlined in the UN Charter as well as the key players, including the UN Security Council and the International Court of Justice. This course aims to give students a deeper understanding of contemporary issues like the global North-South divide as well as the operations of numerous international and regional organisations.
